FINDINGS AND RULING ON DEFENDANT'S
MOTION TO SUPPRESS IDENTIFICATION

The defendant has been charged with one count of OUI Drugs, in violation of G.L. c.90, §24, and one count of Disturbing the Peace, in violation of G.L. c.272, §53. He has moved to suppress any and all statements attributed to him. I have considered the motion as to both constitutional and common law grounds. For the reasons set forth below, the defendant's motion is ALLOWED.

The government offered no testimony of warnings given, of voluntariness, or of any waiver.

CONCLUSION
